GEMT:

The Ground Emergency Medical Transport (GEMT) supplemental funding program is a goal for the IFCA where if successful would allow for any Illinois municipal or fire district agency that provides emergency medical transport to submit for additional Medicaid reimbursement for a percentage of the cost of the service that is outstanding after receipt of the initial Medicaid claim. This could bring millions of additional dollars on an annual basis to agencies that transport Medicaid patients and could open the door for a state wide mobile integrated health care reimbursement program as well. for more info: puknaitism@naperville.il.us
