This **two-day** workshop is designed to assist departments in creating their Community Risk Assessment. Department response data will be provided by the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal. This class will go over how to manipulate and better understand this data. A computer with Excel will be required.

This class will be taught by Steven Hrustich, the Project Manager for Vision 20/20. Hrustich spent 36 years in the fire service, retiring as Fire Chief of multiple career organizations in New York State, and more recently as the Assistant Chief of Community Risk Reduction Division at Gwinnett County Department of Fire Emergency Services in Metro Atlanta. He also serves the Project Manager for Vision 20/20.

As this is an intensive and interactive class, registration is capped at 30 participants. Due to this limitation, **only one person per department will be allowed to attend.**

You must be registered by June 15th to allow time for OSFM to gather and provide response data for your department.
