DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

DeKalb is located in a university community and the Fire Department serves a population of over 16,000 students and 40,290 residents. The Department has an ISO Rating of 2 with a primary response area of 16 square miles and serves an additional 55 square miles by contract to the DeKalb Fire Protection District. In 2022, the DeKalb Fire Department responded to 7,437 requests for emergency service of which 81% were medical calls. The Fire Department is comprised of 64 full-time sworn employees including a Fire Chief, 2 Deputy Chiefs and 2 civilian employees.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process includes submission of an application, written exam, oral interview, background investigation and polygraph exam. Psychological and medical exams are completed upon conditional offer of employment.

REQUIREMENTS:

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AT TIME OF APPLICATION

- Applicants shall be at least 21 years old and under the age of 35 unless exempt from such age limitation as
 provided in Section 5/10-2.1-6 of the <u>Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Act</u>. Proof of birthdate is
 required.
- State of Illinois (IDPH) Paramedic License (EMT-P). Please Note: The EMT-P requirement may be satisfied by a letter issued by an accredited EMT-P training and certification program indicating that at the time of application, the applicant is a student in good standing, with tuition paid in full, who is expected to graduate the EMT-P program with a grade of at least 80%, within the next 3 months. Applicants must have EMT-P status at time of hire, to be eligible for hiring.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Minimum of High School diploma or equivalent.
- US Citizen
- No felony convictions and or crime involving moral turpitude as specified in Section 5/10-2.1-6 Part C of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Act.

ADDITIONAL MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AT TIME OF CONDITIONAL OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT

- Successful completion of the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) with Ladder Climb Certification conducted by a licensed agency within twelve (12) months prior to the conditional offer of employment.
- Valid Driver's License.
- State of Illinois (IDPH) Paramedic License (EMT-P).
- Must pass psychological and medical examinations.

- Copy of EMT-P certification or letter from instructor
- Copy of Valid Driver's License
- Copy of High School diploma or equivalent

Sunday July 16, 2023	Applications and all supporting documentation must be completed.	
July 31 – August 4 OR August 7 – August 10	ORAL INTERVIEWS The top forty (40) candidates who achieved the highest passing scores will be invited to participate in the oral interview. If in the event the 40 th place is a tie score, all candidates that achieve a 40 th place tie score will advance to the oral interview. Those eligible to participate will receive an e-mail notification with the interview schedule. The City of DeKalb Board of Fire and Police Commissioners may consider the remainder of candidates that have achieved a passing score on the written examination as a "reserve list". Such candidates may be called, based upon their written examination score, for an additional round of oral interviews.	
August 2023	Interview Dates are subject to change INITIAL ELIGIBILITY LIST POSTED An initial Eligibility List of applicants will be established in numeric order based on a minimum passing score on the written examination and oral interview.	
August 2023	 SUBMISSION OF PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM Eligible candidates must submit the Preference Points Form with proof thereof within ten (10) days of posting of the Initial Eligibility List or such claim shall be waived. The Preference Points Form will be provided to all candidates included in the Initial Eligibility List. A maximum of 10 preference points shall be available for applicants to claim. • Veteran Preference Points: Five (5) preference points shall be assigned to any applicant who was engaged in active service for at least one (1) year in the United States military, and who was honorably discharged. Reserve or National Guard service without one year of active-duty service shall not entitle an applicant to any Veteran's Preference Points. Residency Preference Points: Two (2) preference points shall be assigned to any applicant who resides at a location that satisfies the residency requirements for a full-time, non-probationary Firefighter/Paramedic under the then-current or most recent collective bargaining agreement between the City and the International Association of Firefighters. Residency is required to be established by a then-current, valid Illinois Driver's License listing an eligible address (as verified through the Illinois Secretary of State), and/or also through such other documentation as shall be acceptable to the Board. Basic Operations Firefighter Certification Points: Three (3) preference points shall be assigned to any applicant who is certified by the Illinois Office of the State Fire Marshall (OFSM), (verified through the OSFM), and/or through other such documentation. 	
August 2023	FINAL ELIGIBILITY LIST POSTED A Final Eligibility List will be established. The list is valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of certification by the City of DeKalb Board of Fire and Police Commissioners.	

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT – within 15 months of date of hire.

If any portion of the incorporated limits of a city, town or village touches the boundaries, all of the city, town or village shall be included within the area.
